#### Curtain Closes for the 2012 Season

#### **NPS Owned Cabins in Wilsonia**

The NPS is currently evaluating the options regarding the NPS owned cabins in Wilsonia that were presented to Wilsonia cabin owners at the July 8th meeting. On September 8th a joint letter from the WHDT, WVI and the Sierra Masonic Family Club was sent to SEKI NPS superintendent Karen Taylor-Goodrich. The letter reiterated our requests:

- 1. That we establish a MOU or MOA that outlines how SEKI NPS will work with the WHDT and the property owners in Wilsonia in the future regardless of which Superintendent resides in Ash Mountain.
- 2. That we develop a mutually beneficial relationship that includes NPS provided information that is accurate as to the NPS current and future actions as they relate to Wilsonia's future and the related Park inten-
- 3. That the NPS owned Historic Cabins that are threatened by further degradation are stabilized prior to this winter to avoid further loss and allow for the consideration of all alternatives currently being considered in the VA.

The NPS plans to complete their study and present the preferred alternative and accept public comments sometime after the first of the year. We plan to meet with the superintendent again at that time.



#### **Road Signs Fundraiser**

Thanks to all of you generous Wilsonians, the Road Sign Fundraiser is over 75% funded. To date we have collected \$2,745 and have pledges of \$500 more. Our goal was to reach \$4200 as the projected cost for the project is \$100 per sign for each of the 42 intersections in Wilsonia. The



construction and installation of the signs is planned for early next summer.

WVI and Tulare County have reached an agreement for the project. WVI will pay for the materials and Tulare County will provide the labor for installation.

The signs will be wooden with wooden cross-arms and brown reflectorized road signs, allowing them to be easily visible to emergency responders and visitors to Wilsonia. A sample is at the corner of Lilac and President's Lanes.

We are still seeking sponsorships for the signs. If you would like to sponsor a sign for \$100 or donate any amount towards the project (or join with neighbors to sponsor one), you may send donations to the address on the back page or contact any WVI Board Member. Thank You!

#### Garbage Service Will Resume in May

Garbage service is suspended each year at the end of October. If you are visiting Wilsonia in the winter months please come prepared to haul-out your garbage, trash or recyclables. Also, the recycle bin is not serviced during the winter months - please do not use it as a trash receptacle.

#### **Big Stump Entrance Station**

To expedite entry when accessing your Wilsonia private property, you may obtain a gold vehicle sticker and use the far right lane at the entrance station.

Wilsonia property owners may obtain the gold stickers for their vehicles at the Kings Canyon Visitor Center or at the Big Stump entry station. Other visitors to Wilsonia can obtain a non-recreation pass. Anyone wishing to visit any of the Park facilities must possess a NPS recreation pass.

#### Winter Parking in Wilsonia

To make life easier for all Wilsonia winter visitors...

- I) Please park your vehicle perpendicular or diagonal to the road, backed in (with the front of the car sticking out) so there will be more parking available.
- 2) Please be available to move your car as necessary for the snow removal equipment to come in and clear the road.
