We require that you be at your property on clean-up day, and also ask that you assist in the clean-up if your are able, or alternately, make a donation to the Wilsonia Fire Committee.

Remember: June is Yard Clean-Up time. Please clear the defensible space around your cabin as soon as possible. All property owners are required to comply; fire inspections will take place in early July.

The NPS dump will be open, and the gate unlocked, for disposal of yard debris during the month of June. Please close the gate behind you as you enter and exit. Please, only natural yard debris, branches, leaves and needles are allowed at the dump. No trash or trash bags are allowed!

Wilsonia's Centennial 2018

Hazard Tree Removal

Due to a high tree mortality in the past few years, there has been a greatly increased effort to remove hazard trees all over the Sierra Nevadas. Locally, in Grant Grove and Wilsonia, this has been done primarily by contract crews working for PG&E: Trees Inc. and Mario's Tree Service. This was a massive effort during the late summer and fall, and will continue this year. If you have questions about hazard trees still standing on or near your property, contact ACRT. Make sure you have your address and cross streets, and a location of the tree, as well as any identifying numbers and letters (if tagged).

If you have trees down on your property, PG&E has a debris management program that should assist you with their removal. All other concerns related to hazard trees or excessive fuel on NPS lots can be directed to John Ziegler, Kings Canyon NP FMO. Additionally, Denise Robertson of the NPS can answer questions regarding the NPS/PG&E policy on hazard tree removal in Wilsonia and the National Park.

Wilsonia garbage service is only for use by *paid* WVI members. So as to not overload the bins and in order for all paid members to have access to this service, please follow these rules:

Please, use the dumpsters only for the daily trash and garbage from your cabin. Please use trash bags (to help keep the smell and mess under control) and compact them as much as possible. Do not throw empty boxes, or large items in the bins. This takes up a lot of space and prevents others from having a place to dispose of their garbage. Do not use the dumpsters for disposal of ashes, remodeling or building materials, furnishings or cabin clean-out refuse. Thanks for your cooperation!


